

Health Requirements for Admission

All students, grades K3-12: A certified copy of your child's birth certificate must be on file. The state's seal will be apparent on the certificate. A copy from the hospital or the "Mother's Copy" is not an official copy and the State Health Department will not allow us to accept that version.

Please select the correct grade level your child is entering this fall and follow the requirements as set forth by the Tennessee Department of Health. Immunizations must be recorded on the "green" immunization card, supplied by your child's physician.

Students entering K3 (three-year-old preschool):

Updated immunization record

- 4 DPT/DTap/DT
- 3 Polio
- 4 Hib – or – 3 doses Pedvax
- 1 MMR (Measles/Mumps and Rubella)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- Proof of Varicella vaccine or Illness

Students entering K4 (four-year-old preschool):

Updated immunization record

- 4 DPT/DTap/DT
- 3 Polio
- 4 Hib – or – 3 doses Pedvax
- 1 MMR (Measles/Mumps and Rubella)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- Proof of Varicella vaccine or Illness

Students entering Kindergarten:

Updated immunization record

- 4 DPT/DTap/DT
- 4 Polio
- 4 Hib – or – 3 doses Pedvax
- 2 MMR (Measles/Mumps and Rubella)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- Proof of Varicella vaccine or Illness
- Physical Examination by medical doctor

Students entering other grades:

Updated immunization record on Tennessee Green Card. The State of Tennessee requires that all students show proof of 2nd MMR (Measles/Mumps and Rubella). For students entering grades K3 through 7, the State of Tennessee **requires** 3 Hepatitis B immunizations. (These immunizations are given over a six-month period.)

Any student entering Tennessee schools for the first time must have a physical examination performed by a medical doctor.
